### Consolidation in logistics set to continue

A survey from Carter Backer Winter and Logistics UK, in conjunction with logistics research firm Analytiqa, notes that companies have a greater appetite for future mergers and acquisitions than they did last year and foresee a greater amount of consolidation. Measures such as mergers and acquisitions are seen as part of the growth plans for companies looking to recover from COVID-19.

Both Brexit and COVID-19 have caused issues for logistics firms and therefore greater consolidation may be a worthwhile avenue for firms. It will be important to consider wider impacts of any consolidation including financial and societal implications, both in the short term as well as the long term.
