### Newly expanded Humber Container Terminal opens for business

Associated British Ports (ABP) have completed their £50 million investment in the expansion of their Humber Container Terminal.

This investment is split between sites in Hull and Immingham. Upgrades and improvements to the Immingham site has extended the footprint of the site as well as

seeing the arrival of two new ship to shore cranes, six electric rubber tyre gantry cranes and upgrades to a car park and replacement of security gates.

These improvements will help to future-proof the terminal and help it operate more efficiently.
